HOW DO I FIT IN?

Our family groups for the weekend are hosted by a family in their home for Friday and Saturday night. Host Homes will typically have approximately 10–12 students in your home plus two leaders. If we need you to host a larger number of students, you will be given that information beforehand for your approval.

WHAT ARE THE HOST HOMES RESPONSIBLE FOR?

You get to minister to students by making them a part of your family for the weekend. You will help with transportation, provide a place to sleep, and provide breakfast on Saturday morning and dinner Saturday evening.

DO I HAVE TO HAVE A BED FOR EVERYONE?

No, the students will bring sleeping bags and just need a spot on your floor. If possible we ask that the family group leaders have a bed.

IS MY HOUSE TOO SMALL?

As long as you have the floor space for them to sleep then your house isn't too small. A lot of people mistakenly think their house has to be big in order to host a group, but that is not true.

CAN I REQUEST A CERTAIN AGE GROUP?

Yes, we will do the best we can but sometimes requests conflict and we cannot accommodate all of them.

DO I NEED TO PROVIDE TRANSPORTATION?

Possibly. Family Group Leaders are responsible for transporting students, but depending on their vehicle capacity, your assistance may be needed throughout the weekend.

WILL IT COST ME ANYTHING?

Yes, you are responsible for some snacks for the students, breakfast on Saturday, and a meal on Saturday night in your home.

CAN'T SOMEBODY ELSE DO IT?

We need over 50 host homes to pull this weekend off. So yes we NEED your help!

DO I NEED TO ENFORCE RULES?

This depends on your group and with the help of the family group leaders you may need to correct someone. It is your home and your rules. If any student becomes a problem you can contact one of the ministers.

IS THERE AN ORIENTATION?

Yes, we will have a meeting on the Sunday prior to the event to go over everything in detail.
