DISCIPLE NOW INFORMATION

What is Disciple Now?

Disciple Now is Feb 15th -17th. This will be a weekend of large group worship, small group Bible study (done in homes and led by our volunteers) and events (an event on Saturday and a Surprise Recreation planned on Saturday). The whole weekend is focused on helping your student connect with others at Lake Pointe Church and become a stronger follower of Jesus.

What is a Host Home?

A Host Home is where your student's small group will meet, sleep and eat when they are not at church. These are all church members who have generously agreed to open their homes for the weekend and transport your student to and from Disciple Now activities. (All leaders have had background checks)

What Should I Pack?

All students should bring their own sleeping bag and pillow (they will sleep on sofas or the floor). Students will also need: a towel, 2 changes of clothes (students will get a T-shirt to wear Sunday morning), hygiene stuff (makeup, deodorant, comb, toothbrush etc.), a Bible, two 2 liters of soda, bag of chips and bag of cookies to share with your group at their host home.

Will My Student Need Any Money?

No, we will provide all meals; just make sure that they eat dinner on Friday before they come to church. On Friday night, students will eat a snack at the host homes and eat the snacks they brought. Saturday morning, students will eat a big breakfast in the host homes; lunch on Saturday will be at the church and dinner that night will be in the host homes. On Sunday morning we all meet at the church for breakfast.

Can Students Drive During the Weekend?

No! Absolutely not for any reason! Students will park their cars at the church on Friday night when they arrive and will not be allowed to drive during the weekend unless they are leaving Disciple Now and have a Leave Form signed by their parents. All transportation for Disciple Now will be provided by an adult(s) from the host home or the college-age small group leaders.

What's a Leave Form and Why Do I Need One?

This form gives parental permission for the student to leave Disciple Now and drive if necessary to attend preplanned events such as ball games, tests or other commitments they may have. The form is only valid when signed by their parent and should be turned into their host home immediately upon arrival.

Can I Attend the Large Group Worship As A Parent?

Yes! We would love to have you in any of the large group worship times. There is no cost for parents to attend. Just know that these services are geared specifically for teens. So it may be loud and crazy, but it's all aimed at Jesus! If you have any questions contact: (insert you info)

WHAT TO BRING

- *A 2-liter bottle of pop and a bag of chips or a bag of cookies
- *Clothes for Play and Worship
- *Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothbrush, towel, deodorant, etc.)
- *Sleeping Bag and Pillow (Expect to sleep on the floor)
- *Bible, Pen, and Paper*Clothes for 2 days...not 22 days, girls!
- *You can bring your phone, but use will be limited

WHAT NOT TO BRING

- *Drugs, Tobacco, and Alcohol
- *Weapons of Any Kind
- *A Bad Attitude

SIMPLE RULES

1. Be on time.
2. Be Respectful to People and Property.
3. Students are allowed to drive to Disciple Now, but will not be allowed to drive during Disciple Now.
4. GO TO BED ON TIME.
5. If you must leave for "a parent-approved" activity, that is ok. Just come back when you can.
